

GSVO Tier Rating Process

Apprentice

Officials who are in their first year with GSVO. An official who is cleared to officiate in their first year will be either a Tier I or Tier II, with an apprentice label. This label will be removed after their first season.

Tier I

Officials cleared to work as Line Judges, Scorekeepers and/or Libero trackers. Officials working on being cleared for R1/R2.

- Attend meetings
- Pass test with 70%
- Complete RTO

Tier II

Officials cleared to handle subvarsity matches on their own, and able to handle R2 duties with an experienced R1.

- Attend meetings
- Work 10 games as R1/R2
- Pass test with 70%
- Complete RTO

Tier III

Officials should be proficient in the application of volleyball rules and be able to handle most situations that may occur at a high school match as either an R1 or R2. Eligible for State at assignor discretion *if needed*.

- Attend meetings
- Work 10 games as R1/R2
- Pass test with 75%
- Complete RTO

Tier IV

Officials should be proficient in the application of volleyball rules at all levels of high school and below. Capable of game management & mentorship. Officiate State at least once every three years (if asked).

- Attend meetings
- Work 10 games as R1/R2
- Pass test with 85%
- Complete RTO

Requirements for Good Standing:

Requirements for promotion:

- Volunteer at subvarsity matches
- Volunteer at jamborees
- Get feedback from your partner
 - Get partner to provide feedback to Assignor as well
- Once ready, contact Ratings Chair & Assignor to be scheduled for R1/R2 clearing
 - no cost

- Be Tier II (without Apprentice label) for 1 full season
- Meet Tier III good standing requirements
- Complete Tier III Notebook
- Optional: Receive two recommendations from current Tier III/IV officials
- On Court Eval with Partner and Rater (75% pass)
 - cost of \$100 for rater

- Be Tier III for 1 full season
- Meet Tier IV good standing requirements
- Optional: Receive two recommendations from current Tier IV officials
- On Court Observation
 - cost of \$100 for Rater
- On Court Eval with Partner and two Raters (85% pass)
 - cost of \$200 for Raters
